1.) The person using the fireworks **MUST** apply for, and possess a Town of Oulu Fireworks Permit. Permit application must be applied for and approved a minimum of one week, (7) days, prior to event/usage. The Fireworks Permit application may be acquired from the Town clerk or their designee.

2.) The Permit is for Class "C<sup>t</sup>" fireworks (also known as "Consumer" or '1 .4g" fireworks) only.

Note: Class "B" fireworks (also known as "Display" or "1.3g" fireworks) can only be possessed by ATF certified personnel. Class 'B' fireworks are permissible for usage **ONLY** with submission of a copy of the pertinent ATF certification(s) allowing class "B" fireworks possession and usage. ATF documentation must be included with, and clearly designated on, the Permit application.

3) A copy of applicants' homeowners and/or general insurance liability page must be included with the Permit Application or in the case of a certified professional, a copy of the face page of your professional liability insurance.

4) A copy of the permit must be on hand and available from the responsible permit holder at the time and place of the scheduled event.

5) Fireworks usage hours are as follow:

For three (3) days immediately prior to the 4th of July, on the actual 4th of July and three (3) days immediately after the 4th of July, approved hours are 10 am until 11:30 pm.

- For all other days of the year, the permit is good for a three (3) hour period, to be designated on the Permit, but only between the hours of 10 am and 11 pm on the day requested.
- 6) Applicant is required to pick up any and all fireworks litter on the event premises as listed on the Permit on any public or private property, including any waterway(s).
  - 7) It is the permittees responsibility to abide by all DNR fire warnings, and follow all applicable rules and laws regarding the discharge of fireworks.
  - 8) Permit holder agrees to have the general location (nearest crossroads) of the fireworks discharge posted on the Town of Oulu website to alert area residents of the display to plan for their own safety and animal safety.
  - 9) Permit holder agrees to hold the Town of Oulu harmless and assumes all responsibility for any and all damages to property, livestock, pets, etc., as a result of fireworks discharge.
  - 10) Permit holder agrees that the Town of Oulu has the right to cancel any and all fireworks permits at any time to maintain the safety of the town and its residents.

The permit holder is required to send/deliver a copy of this permit to the Iron River Fire Department, at least 2 days prior to the date of authorized use of the listed fireworks.
